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Policy

It is the policy of Shiawassee County Community Mental Health Authority (SCCMHA) that all consumers of the benefit population will have access to the entire array of specific clinical services based upon the criteria of medical necessity. In order to ensure the availability of covered services for the consumer population, a set of clinical protocols will be established that identify the guiding parameters that determine access and utilization management processes.

Purpose

To ensure the protection of rights or recipients receiving services from SCCMHA.

To ensure established clinical protocols guide the availability of covered services.

To ensure compliance with the Michigan Mental Health Code, the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services, Administrative Rules and the standards of accrediting bodies.

Application


This policy will apply to all SCCMHA programs and services.
